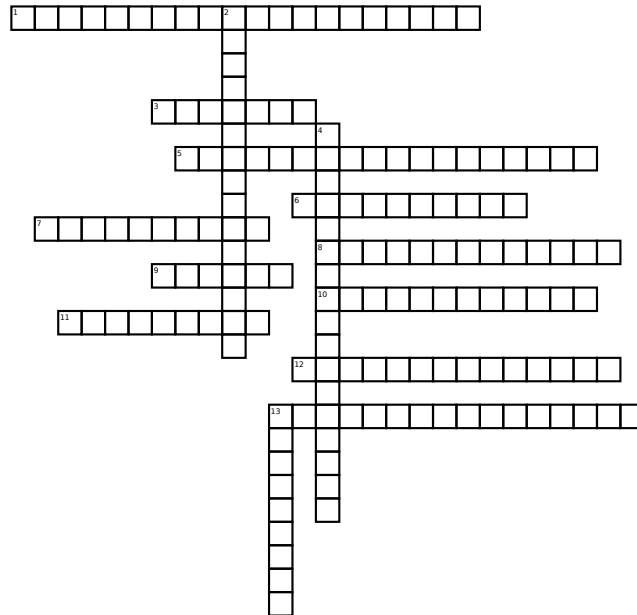


Elections Yukon



Down:

2. a ballot from the ballot box that was not marked correctly. This ballot is not included in the tally
4. an area designated by the Electoral District Boundaries Act, for which one MLA (and one Returning Officer) is appointed
13. a person's true, fixed, permanent home or habitation to which, whenever absent, the person has the intention of returning; a person may have only one residence at a time

Across:

1. Elections Yukon mails personalized cards to all registered electors
3. a person who, on polling day, is a Canadian citizen who is at least 18 years of age and a resident of Yukon for the previous 12 months
5. Electors can write in the name of a candidate if known, or the name of a registered political party on these ballots
6. a candidate's representative appointed to observe election activities; previously called an agent
7. is the day most people go to vote. Also known as Election Day
8. a person appointed by a candidate, and named on the Nomination Paper, to handle

campaign finances and to act on the candidate's behalf

9. a ballot paper is unmarked and becomes a ballot when placed into the ballot box
10. refers to all polling stations set up at polling places for the two days of advance voting. Th
11. a qualified elector who has been nominated to represent the electoral district if elected as a member of the Legislative Assembly
12. a list of eligible electors for a designated area (polling division or electoral district)
13. an election officer appointed by the CEO responsible for the management of the electoral event within their electoral district.
