JOB OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOUTH

POLL ATTENDANT (PA)

The Poll Attendant is the first election officer that electors encounter.

They help with the set-up and take down of the polling place, greet electors, assess their need to register and directs them to the appropriate station.

Hours: 7 to 14 hours/day

Pay: \$20.77/hour
