Interested electors can apply online at <a href="https://electionsyukon.ca">electionsyukon.ca</a>.</li> <li>• Returning offices open for electors to vote early by special ballot</li> </ul>
<b>ELECTION ACTIVITY</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Returning offices are taking registrations, issuing special ballots, conducting targeted revision, and confirming polling places.</li> <li>• Help desk supporting questions from the public, electors, political parties, and returning offices.</li> <li>• Returning offices are open today 3pm to 8 pm.</li> <li>• Returning offices operating in 21 electoral districts and six satellite communities (Beaver Creek, Pelly Crossing, Carmacks, Ross River, Watson Lake and Teslin.</li> </ul>
<b>PLEBISCITE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Plebiscite information, FAQ’s and a plebiscite voter guide are available on the website.</li> </ul>
<b>ELECTORAL DISTRICTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• With new districts and changed boundaries, electors can confirm their electoral district at ‘Find My District” at <a href="https://electionsyukon.ca">electionsyukon.ca</a></li> </ul>
<b>REGISTRATIONS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Electors can check, update, and register at <a href="https://electionsyukon.ca">electionsyukon.ca</a></li> <li>• Current number of registered electors: 35, 643. Change results from data released by Yukon Bureau of Statistics on October 2<sup>nd</sup> (update on deceased electors). Corrections ongoing.</li> <li>• Number of registered electors: 35,760 at issue of the writ.</li> </ul>
<b>VICs</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Voter Information Cards (VICs) will be available after October 10, 2025 once polling places are confirmed.</li> <li>• ‘Where Do I Vote?’ Information and digital Voter Information Cards will be available online after October 10, 2025. Mail out of VICs to be determined.</li> </ul>
<b>CANDIDATES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Close of Nomination is Tuesday October 14, 2025, at 2PM.</li> <li>• Candidates Approved by Elections Yukon: 6</li> <li>• Days remaining until close of nominations: 8</li> </ul>
<b>ADVANCE POLLS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Open Sunday and Monday, October 26 and 27, 2025 from 8AM to 8PM.</li> <li>• Days remaining until first day of Advance Poll: 20</li> </ul>
<b>SPECIAL BALLOTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Special ballot applications close October 21, 2025 8:00 PM for mail out. Applications remain open at Returning Offices until Friday Oct 31, 2025.</li> <li>• Days remaining to apply for special ballot: 25</li> <li>• Total special ballots Issued: 69</li> <li>• Special ballots sent by courier: 39 Returned: 0</li> <li>• Special ballot votes cast in returning offices): 30</li> </ul>
