



## INVITATION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON AUTHORIZED ELECTOR IDENTIFICATION

Following a territorial general election, Elections Yukon conducts a review of authorized identification which is submitted to the Members' Services Board of the Legislative Assembly for approval. The public is invited to provide comment on the kinds of identification that electors should be able to use for election purposes.

Electors must prove their identity and residential address to vote. The Elections Act provides a number of options that enables electors – including those without conventional types of identification – to participate. Authorized identification includes:

- **One piece of identification.** Government issued such as a driver's license, Health Care Insurance Card, Vehicle registration, or trapping license; or
- **Two pieces of identification.** Both with name and one must have current residential address or mailing address. There are over 40 acceptable pieces. Includes birth certificates, passports, membership cards, marriage certificates, camping permit, credit card or utility bill statements; or
- **Attestations:** Available for electors who may be unable to provide other types of identification including care center and hospitalized electors, electors without a fixed address, tenant electors, and incarcerated electors; or
- **Vouching.** An elector at a polling station who is unable to provide authorized identification may appoint a vouching elector whose name appears on the List of Electors for his or her electoral district; or
- **Declarations.** An elector unable to provide authorized identification and does not appoint a vouching elector may vote after completing a signed declaration administered by an election officer at the polling place.
